

2024 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ACCELERATED GOLF TOUR

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male and female amateur high school and college students. Entries are subject to rejection at any time. Current High School Graduates may elect to enter either the High School or College Division.

REGISTRATION

No Membership Fee required!

All events include golf, range balls and automatic entry into event drawings.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Entry fee does not include practice round green fees. Players may contact the event facility directly for availability and cost. Practice round information will be listed at acceleratedgolftour.org

CADDIES

Caddies are not permitted in AGT Tournaments.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT and REQUIREMENTS

Four 9-hole stroke play competitions played over two days. 100 players per event will be accepted.

Divisions: College Men/Women; High School Men/Women. Check in upon arrival each day.

PACE OF PLAY

At each competition, the expected pace of play will be noted on the player's scorecard. The stipulated round is complete when the last player in the group completes play of the final hole and the flagstick is securely in the last hole played.

COURSE SET UP

The AGT will monitor the yardage set up for the courses on a day-to-day basis. Changes may be made as a result of weather conditions, or any unforeseen problems.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Inappropriate behavior by any player, witnessed by our staff, fellow competitor, or employee of the host facility may result in a warning, 1 or 2 stroke penalty, disqualification from the current event, and their next event, without a refund. Inappropriate behavior could include, but is not limited to: the use of improper language, dressing in non-golf attire, throwing clubs, damaging the course, failure to repair ball marks on the greens or replace divots on the course, cheating, talking while a fellow competitor is playing a shot, knowingly violating the rules of golf, affecting play of another, overall display of poor sportsmanship or the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs.

DRESS CODE

Players are expected to wear golf-appropriate attire at all times when using the practice facilities, golf course, or while visiting the clubhouse. Womens' sleeveless shirts must have a collar. Mens' shirts must be tucked in. No short-shorts, short skorts/skirts, jeans, cut-offs, tank tops, t-shirts, halter tops, bathing suits, or the like are permitted. No metal or ceramic spikes are permitted. This dress code will be strictly enforced by the AGT Staff.

2024 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ACCELERATED GOLF TOUR

ALL SPECTATORS are expected to follow the player code of conduct and the player dress code. Spectators must remain on the cart path, except to look for a ball as permitted by the USGA.

EVENT AWARDS

Winners of each division will receive gift certificates.

10 or more players in a division: 1st: \$65 2nd: \$40 3rd: \$25

In events with 9 or fewer participants in a division, awards will be determined by AGT Staff. (If gift certificates are not permitted, an alternate award will be provided.)

PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Players will accumulate points throughout the current scheduled events. At the conclusion of the year, winners in each of the four AGT Divisions will be recognized. Players must play in a minimum of three events to be eligible. A maximum of 5 events will be counted. If the golfer plays in more than 5 events, the 5 best rankings will be used.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1st 10 3rd 8 5th 6 7th 4 2nd 9 4th 7 6th 5 8th 3

With 5 or less participants in a division:

1st 5 2nd 4 3rd 2

MEDIA RELEASE

The AGT may arrange for promotion of all events for radio, television, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication, including but not limited to social media websites. The player, or person registering the player if a minor, must consent to use by the AGT, or persons authorized by the AGT of the player's name, likeness, voice and references to all photographs and other images connected with the player's appearance in these events or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition or other promotional media.
